Baltic Way Mathematical Team Competition 2007

First Announcement

The mathematical team competition Baltic Way 2007 will take place in Copenhagen, Denmark, from Thursday, 1 November to Monday, 5 November. We hope to see participating teams from all countries around the Baltic Sea or Nordic countries.

Your team should consist of five students, accompanied by a leader and a deputy leader. The leader will be a member of the International Jury. The deputy leader will assist the leader in selecting and translating the problems and in the evaluation process.

During the 4½ hours competition each team has to solve 20 problems from various fields of mathematics traditionally included in mathematical olympiads. The team should work collectively and submit only one solution to each problem. Only writing and drawing materials are allowed. The answers are initially evaluated by the leader and deputy leader, and the final scores are finally decided by the coordinators. See enclosed Regulations.

Thursday, November 1, arrival of the teams

Friday, November 2, excursion, selection and translation of problems

Saturday, November 3, competition, coordination and setting of the result

Sunday, November 4, excursion, closing ceremony, farewell dinner

Monday, November 5, departure

Also, we kindly request you to provide the name and sex of each student and leader no later than October 3.

We kindly request that each country or region proposes about 5 problems, to be received no later than September 14.
